Investment Objectives

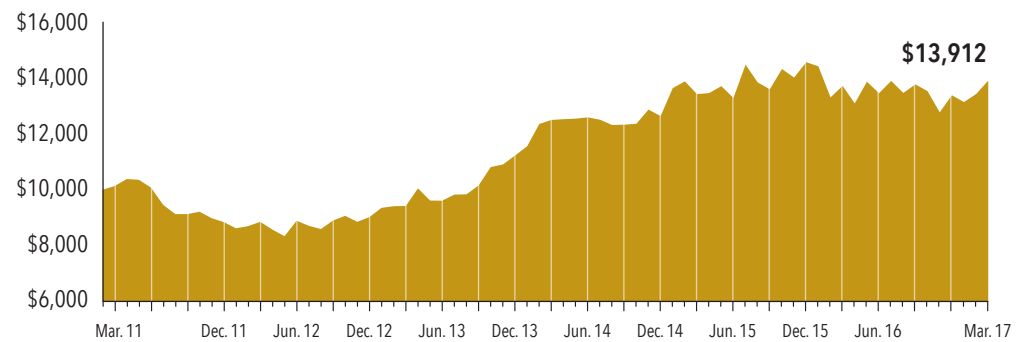

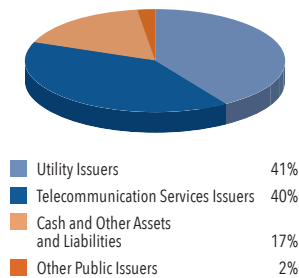

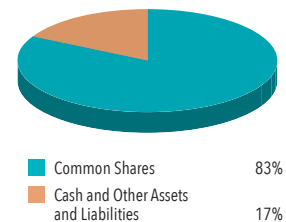
Cumulative Growth: \$10,000 Invested
