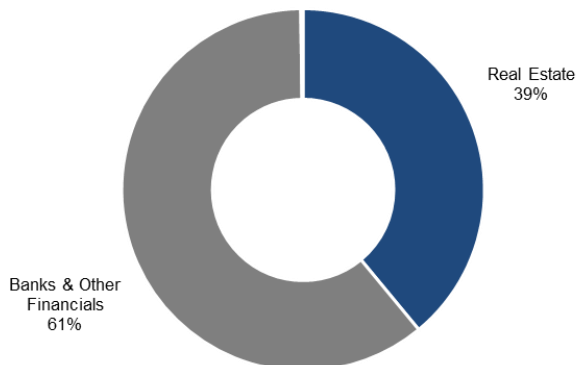
World Class Portfolio of Financials and Real Estate, as at February 28, 2018



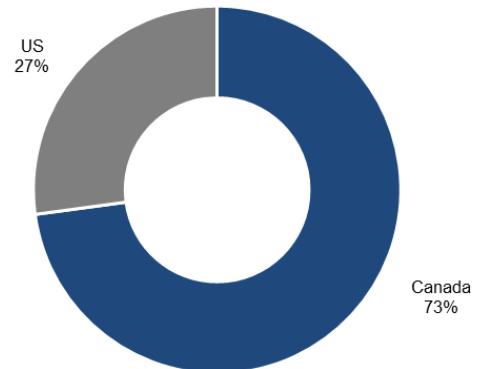
